Christy has been renowned for producing some of the best towels and linen ever since their establishment in 1850. All of their towels are at least 500gms, which offers superior softness and absorbency, and they are such great quality that they even provide their products to Wimbledon!

The best way to ensure your towel stays at its best is to wash and care for it properly. Without proper care, they can often begin to lack softness, absorbency and durability. Without these properties your towel will not dry you effectively, can become gritty, and will often thin out.

Care instructions

- Limit the use of fabric softener to stop fabric damage. Towels will feel softer, however conditioner causes a layer to form that prevents water absorbency.
- Avoid washing towels with garments with zips or hooks; these can catch on the towel and cause pulled threads. Christy towels are woven, meaning the pulled thread won't run so you can simply cut it off.

Colour advice

- Do not wash with bleach products; they will remove the colouring of your Christy towels.
- Some facial cleaning products contain Benzoyl Peroxide which will have the same effect as bleach. This may not become apparent until after you have washed the item.
- Separate light towels and dark towels, as you would with normal washing.
- Darker, brighter or bold colours may run during their first few washes due to excess dye.



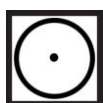
This symbol stands for machine washable. Check the label on your towel to see what temperature it should be washed at.



This symbol means you should not wash your garments with bleach.



This symbol indicates that you cannot dry clean your towels.



This symbol means you can tumble dry your towels. Christy recommends a low heat.
